

Classroom Procedures

Welcome to 8th grade Pre-Algebra/College Algebra 1! We will have a safe and orderly classroom. Listed below are the procedures we will be following to ensure a successful year for all!

- Come to class on time and prepared each day. This includes bringing your covered textbook, workbook, completed homework, math binder, and pencil/eraser. You will not be allowed to go back to your locker once the bell rings. Do not ask to be an exception.
- Go directly to assigned seat and begin work on timed daily warm-up assignment, and put your homework on your desk to be checked/reviewed.
- Pay attention during class, take notes, write down examples, ask questions about any material you do not understand.
- Write your homework assignments, quiz/test dates in your assignment notebook.
- Watch your mouth! No teasing, yelling, swearing, etc. in the classroom.
- Out of respect for all, raise your hand when you want to speak.
- No eating, drinking, or chewing gum in the classroom.
- No writing on desks or destroying school property, including textbooks, in-class materials, calculators, etc.

A note on homework; all work must be shown for credit. If you choose not to show your work or choose to use pen, I will assume you do not want credit for the assignment and you will be given a zero. It is your responsibility to make up missed work from an absence. Check the website or call a friend to get the assignment and turn it in no later than two days after you return to get credit.

- The consequences for not following procedures are:
- After school detention/lunch detention.
- Additional detention and a call home.
- Office referral
